

RESOLUTION 2021 - 198

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE SURPLUSING AND DISPOSAL OF 43 TASER CARTRIDGES HELD BY THE POLICE DEPARTMENT WHICH ARE NO LONGER NEEDED AND TRANSFER TO THE OGLETHORPE COUNTY SHERIFF'S OFFICE; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the City of Powder Springs Police Department is in possession of forty three taser cartridges which are incompatible with the newly replaced tasers; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the provisions of O.C.G.A. § 17-5-54, the City is authorized to dispose of taser cartridges as provided for by O.C.G.A.; and

WHEREAS, further, the City is authorized to dispose of personal property which has an estimated value of \$500.00 or less without the requirement of engaging in a bid process; and


WHEREAS, the Oglethorpe County Sheriff's Department is willing to purchase the taser cartridge at \$34.88 each for an aggregate total of \$1500.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council of the City of Powder Springs that it declares as surplus the forty-three taser cartridges held by the Police Department which are not compatible with and no longer needed for such purposes, finds that all such items are worth less than \$500 each, and authorizes the transfer of said cartridges to the Oglethorpe County Sheriff's Department. This resolution shall become effective immediately upon adoption.






