

RESOLUTION NO. 2026 - 003

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE AMENDMENTS TO SUB RECIPIENT AGREEMENTS UNDER THE COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT PROGRAM TO EXTEND DEADLINES TO COMPLETE PROJECTS; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.


WHEREAS Cobb County receives Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) funds under Title 1 of the Housing and Community Development Act of 1974 to carry out various community development activities in unincorporated areas and in municipalities participating in the CDBG program, including the City of Powder Springs (the "City"); and

WHEREAS the City receives an annual fair share amount from the CDBG program and previously approved and authorized its Program 2023, 2024 and 2025 allocations to complete certain public facility and infrastructure improvements; and


WHEREAS from time-to-time program projects require extensions of time to complete, and to the extent such extension is not implicit in the City's authorization to execute contracts and complete projects, the City desires to specifically approve an extension to June 30, 2026 of all outstanding program funds and to ratify any extension agreements previously executed.

BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council for the City of Powder Springs it approves and authorizes the mayor to execute amendments to its subrecipient agreements for program years 2023, 2024 and 2025 to extend project completion dates to June 30, 2026, and to ratify any extension agreement previously executed.


