**A RESOLUTION APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE RENEWAL LEASE AGREEMENTS WITH THE SOUTH COBB ARTS ALLIANCE, INC. 
**WHEREAS**, the City has an existing lease agreement with the SCAA for gallery to display, promote and showcase local artists; and






