

RESOLUTION NO. 2020 - 092

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT WITH BSN SPORTS FOR CROWD BARRICADE FENCING FOR THE DOWNTOWN PARK IN THE AMOUNT OF \$14,329.77; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the City of Powder Springs (“City”) desires to acquire crowd control fencing for the downtown park to help implement and manage social distancing guidelines recommended by the Centers for Disease Control to help reduce the spread of infectious disease as well as to implement and manage future ticket sale events for which a limited number of patrons would be allowed to attend;

WHEREAS, the City desires to approve the purchase of said fencing for a cost of \$14,329.77;

BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED by the Council for the City of Powder Springs that the Mayor is authorized to execute any document required for the purchase of crowd control barricades from BSN Sports for an amount of \$14,329.77, subject to review and approval by the City Attorney. The resolution shall become effective immediately upon approval.
