
**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF ROADS IN THE DOWNTOWN ON JUNE 19, 2022 TO ACCOMMODATE THE FIRST ANNUAL JUNETHEENTH CELEBRATION AT THURMAN SPRINGS PARK; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Powder Springs (the "City") has received a partnership application from Unity in History to host a Juneteenth celebration on June 19, 2022 at Thurman Springs Park from 11am to 9pm;


