RESOLUTION 2020 - 040

A RESOLUTION APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE A CHANGE ORDER TO THE AGREEMENT WITH EAST COAST GRADING, INC. FOR AN AMOUNT OF \$173,395.70 TO MILL, RESURFACE AND STRIPE HOTEL AVENUE TO PROVIDE ADDITIONAL DOWNTOWN PARKING AND TO RELOCATE SEWER AND STORMWATER LINES BETWEEN HOTEL AVENUE, LEWIS ROAD AND MARIETTA STREET; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the City of Powder Springs ("City") previously approved and authorized East Coast Grading, Inc. as the low bidder in a competitive bid process to resurface and improve Jackson Way to provide additional downtown parking and to expand the municipal parking lot adjacent to Hotel Avenue for general streets improvements under the Special Purpose Local Options Sales Tax program;

WHEREAS, the City desires to complete additional streets improvements and add parking on Hotel Avenue to provide more parking and to relocate utilities from private property on Hotel Avenue and Lewis Road and place said utilities within the public right of way or public property on Hotel Avenue, Lewis Road and Marietta Street and East Coast Grading is willing to complete said work under the terms and prices of its existing contract for a price of \$173,395.70;

WHEREAS, the City now desires a change order to the agreement in order to complete general streets improvements and utility relocations on or near Hotel Avenue, Lewis Road and Marietta Street; and

NOW THEREFORE, be it hereby resolved by the Mayor and Council of the City of Powder Springs that the proposed change order submitted by East Coast Grading, Inc. for an amount of \$173,395.70 to mill, resurface and stripe Hotel Avenue and to relocate utilities on or near Hotel Avenue, Lewis Road and Marietta Street is approved, and the Mayor is authorized to execute a change order with East Coast Grading, Inc. for additional improvements, subject to review and approval by the City Attorney.
