AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE BUDGET FOR FISCAL YEAR 2019 TO ALLOCATE FUNDS TO THE COMMUNITY EVENTS BUDGET FOR EXPENSES ASSOCIATED WITH SPONSORING THE JULY 4 INDEPENDENCE DAY CELEBRATION; TO ESTABLISH AN EFFECTIVE DATE; TO REPEAL CONFLICTING ORDINANCES; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council of the City of Powder Springs have determined that circumstances warrant a change in Fiscal year 2019 budget to allocate funds from unrestricted reserves to community events for expenses associated with sponsoring the July 4 Independence Day celebration in the amount of \$10,000;
