

RESOLUTION NO. 2017-151


A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING AND AUTHORIZING THE REPAIR OF A SANITATION TRUCK BY PAULDING COMMERCIAL VEHICLES FOR AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$2,600; AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT TO EFFECTUATE SAME; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the City of Powder Springs (the "City") Public Works Department has identified defects in a sanitation vehicle relating to a gear box and front pinions that cannot be performed by fleet maintenance staff;

WHEREAS, quotes were solicited and obtained, and the City desires to accept the quote submitted by Paulding Commercial Vehicles as the lowest most responsive quote;

NOW THEREFORE, be it hereby resolved by the Mayor and Council of the City of Powder Springs that it accepts and approves the quote submitted by Paulding Commercial Vehicles for an amount not to exceed \$2,600 to complete repairs on a sanitation truck and further authorizes the Mayor to execute agreements needed to complete said repairs, subject to review and approval by the City Attorney. This resolution shall be effective immediately upon adoption.

SO RESOLVED this 6th day of November, 2017.




