A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING A HAZARD MITIGATION GRANT TO ACQUIRE AND DEMOLISH TWO (2) FLOOD PRONE RESIDENTIAL STRUCTURES AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE ANY NECESSARY DOCUMENTATION TO EFFECTUATE SAME; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the City has previously adopted a Hazard Mitigation Plan to address flood hazards; and

WHEREAS, the City has received notification from the Georgia Emergency Management and Homeland Security Agency that the Federal Emergency Management Agency has approved a Hazard Mitigation Grant Program (HMGP) award to acquire and demolish two (2) flood prone residential structures; and

WHEREAS, the total approved cost of such acquisition and demolition is \$214,760, of the federal share is \$161,070, the state's share is \$21,476, and the City's share is \$32,214; and

WHEREAS, funding for the City's share is available from emergency preparedness funds.

NOW THEREFORE, be it hereby resolved by the Mayor and Council of the City of Powder Springs that the HMGP award is accepted and the subject acquisition and demolition is approved, and the Mayor is authorized to execute any documentation necessary to effectuate same after to review and approval by the City Attorney. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon adoption.
