

RESOLUTION 2020-063

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE THE FEDERAL FISCAL YEAR COBB URBAN COUNTY COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT PROGRAM COOPERATION AGREEMENT; ESTABLISHING AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) has determined that Cobb County is eligible as an urban county to receive entitlement Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) funds under Title 1 of the Housing and Community Development Act of 1974;

WHEREAS, HUD permits urban counties and their participating municipalities to execute Cooperation Agreements which are to be automatically renewing at the end of each three-year qualification period, unless changes in the agreement are required by HUD that would necessitate the execution of a new Agreement or unless the participating municipality elects to be excluded from the agreement at the beginning the agreement term;

WHEREAS, the City of Powder Springs and Cobb County desire to renew their three-year cooperation agreement for Federal Fiscal Year 2020-2023;

BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED by the Council for the City of Powder Springs that the Mayor is authorized to execute the attached Cobb County Community Development Block Grant Program Cooperation Agreement, subject to review by the City Attorney. This resolution shall become effective immediately upon adoption.


