

RESOLUTION 2022 - 012

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE OF POLICE VEHICLES; AUTHORIZING AND APPROVING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE AGREEMENTS FOR THE PURCHASE AND EQUIPPING OF ONE F150 K-9 UNIT AND TWO FORD EXPLORERS FOR AN AMOUNT OF \$124,345.08; ESTABLISHING AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the City of Powder Springs has a rolling stock of vehicles assigned to sworn personnel, a number of which are beyond the recommended useful life of five years;

WHEREAS, the City authorized the purchase of police vehicles in the FY22 capital budget;

WHEREAS, the police department recommends the purchase of one fully equipped F150 for the K9 unit at a cost of \$43,053.98 to replace a 2015 vehicle and the purchase of two fully equipped Ford Explorers at a cost of \$79,791.10 to replace 2016 vehicles;

WHEREAS, the City desires to authorize the purchase under state contract with Virgil Ford of one F150 for an amount of \$35,155 and two Ford Explorers at an amount of \$33,273 each and \$21,144.08 for vehicle equipment from Dana Supply and \$1500 each for decals from Gregory Quality Printing for an overall total amount of \$124,345.08 using budgeted capital funds;

WHEREAS, given shortages experienced in the supply chain of goods and products, the City desires to authorize the use of the remaining balance in the police vehicle capital budget of \$13,314.18 to cover cost increases that may occur with said vehicles and equipment, subject to review and approval by the City Manager and Finance Director.

BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED by the Council for the City of Powder Springs that it authorizes the purchase and equipping of two Ford Explorers and one F150 under state contract for an amount of \$124,345.08 and authorizes the Mayor to execute any agreements required to complete said purchase, subject to review and approval by the City Attorney.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the remaining balance may be used to supplement cost increases for said vehicles and equipment resulting for supply chain issues, subject to review and approval by the City Manager and Finance Department. This resolution shall be effective upon adoption.

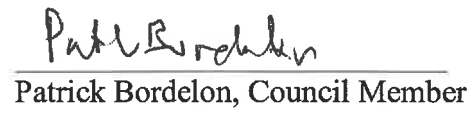
