

RESOLUTION NO. 2019 - 152

A RESOLUTION APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT WITH RICKETT RHODES EVENTS TO DEVELOP AND HOST THE INDEPENDENCE DAY CELEBRATION ON JULY 4; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the City solicited and received a proposal to plan and execute the Independence Day Celebration on July 4, 2020;

WHEREAS, the one proposal received was evaluated by a committee of Parks, Police and Public Works department personnel, and the City desires to accept the recommendation of its professional staff to engage Ricketts Rhodes Events;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council of the City of Powder Springs that it approves and authorizes the Mayor and Council to negotiate an agreement with Ricketts Rhodes Events relating to event features and location for the July 4 Independence Day celebration.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Mayor is authorized to execute said negotiated agreement, subject to review and approval by the City Attorney and subject to budgeted expenses of \$15,000.00 and personnel overtime cost unless a budget amendment is approved. This resolution shall become effective immediately upon adoption.


