

## RESOLUTION 2025 - 127


**A RESOLUTION AMENDING RESOLUTION 2025-065 TO ALLOW THE SOUTH COBB ARTS ALLIANCE TO POST SIGNS ON PUBLIC RIGHT OF WAY AND TRAILS REGARDING THE 5K AND ARTS FESTIVAL HOSTED BY THE SCAA ON SEPTEMBER 13, 2025 FROM 7AM TO 8PM BEGINNING AND ENDING AT THURMAN SPRINGS PARK; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.**


**WHEREAS** the City of Powder Springs ("City") previously adopted Resolution 2025-065 to approve the issuance of a temporary special event permit to the South Cobb Arts Alliance ("SCAA") to host a 5K and arts festival on the City's 5K certified route using city trails and streets and beginning and ending at Thurman Springs Park on September 13, 2025 from 7AM to 8PM; and

**WHEREAS** the SCAA requested and the City finds it in the public interest to amend said resolution to authorize the SCAA to post public notices signs in advance of said event on certain public properties, including the city trails, upon payment of a refundable deposit of \$100, which shall be returned upon the removal of all signs following the event.


**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED** by the Mayor and Council of the City of Powder Springs that it amends Resolution 2025-065 to authorize the SCAA to post public notice signs in advance of its 5K and arts festival on September 13, 2025, subject to payment of a refundable deposit of \$100, which shall be refunded upon the SCAA's prompt removal of all signs immediately following said event.

**SO RESOLVED AND EFFECTIVE** this 18<sup>th</sup> day of August 2025.


