A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING AND APPROVING THE PROPOSAL FROM CROY ENGINEERING IN THE AMOUNT OF \$8,850.00 TO DESIGN HANDRAILS FOR THE ACCESSIBLE RAMP AT THE CITY HALL FACILITY AND TO OVERSEE CONSTRUCTION OF THE RAMP AND HANDRAILS; AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXEUCTE AN AGREEMENT WITH CROY ENGINEERING; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the City of Powder Springs (the "City") previously approved the installation of an upgraded accessible ramp at the City Hall facility but received information during the permitting process that handrails would be required in order to receive approval from the Fire Marshal's Office;

WHEREAS, the City solicited and received proposals to design the required handrails and to oversee construction of the handrails and accessible ramp and Croy Engineering was deemed to be the lowest and most responsive bidder;

NOW THEREFORE, be it hereby resolved by the Mayor and Council of the City of Powder Springs that the proposal submitted by Croy Engineering to design handrails and to oversee construction of handrails and the accessible ramp at the City Hall facility at a cost of \$8,850.00 is accepted and approved, and the Mayor is authorized to execute an agreement to effectuate same after review and approval by the City Attorney.
