## 21st AMENDMENT TO PROGRAM MANAGEMENT SERVICES AGREEMENT

Croy will develop a detailed concept plan including basic design and grading lines for temporary parking lots and to facilitate bidding the work with three bidders. The parking areas will be located at 4491 Marietta Street, and 3800 Brownsville Road. This work will be completed using GIS data.
