
**WHEREAS** the City of Powder Springs ("City") Police Department has identified certain operational needs unfunded in the current fiscal year general fund operational budget, certain personnel savings from open positions, and certain capital budget projects or programs that can be postponed or completed in an alternative manner that will not require the full amount allocated in the capital budget; and


**WHEREAS** the City desires to amend the FY25 budget to reflect the transfer of funds between the capital and operational budgets and police and information technology budgets..

**NOW THEREFORE**, the Mayor and Council of the City of Powder Springs hereby ordain that the budget ordinance for the Fiscal Year 2025 be amended as set forth in the attached Exhibit "A".

**BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED**, that all ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict herewith hereby repealed, and this ordinance shall become effective immediately upon execution by the Mayor and City Council.

**SO ORDAINED** this 20<sup>th</sup> day of January 2026.




