A RESOLUTION APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE A TRIAL USE AGREEMENT WITH CELLCO PARTNERSHIP, D/B/A VERIZON WIRELESS FOR THE TEMPORARY USE AND DEMONSTRATION OF CERTAIN EQUIPMENT; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.


WHEREAS Cellco Partnership, d/b/a Verizon Wireless (hereinafter, “Verizon”) currently provides the City Sono MiFi’s to provide internet connectivity to access necessary software for employees to perform off site or in areas with inadequate connectivity; and


WHEREAS the Sono MiFi allows the police department to connect to the VPS providing access to various mobile applications in their patrol vehicles but from time to time lose connection and do not hold a charge for the duration of an officers shift; and


WHEREAS Verizon has offered to demonstrate the latest Verizon Cradle Point MiFi option to allow the police and information technology departments to determine if the alternate equipment better meets the City’s needs, and the City desires to test the equipment for a period of time and authorize a temporary agreement relating to the trial use of said equipment.


