A RESOLUTION APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR OR MAYOR PRO TEM TO EXECUTE AN INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT WITH COBB COUNTY FOR FLEET MAINTENANCE SERVICES; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the City is a Georgia municipal corporation authorized by its Charter to provide for the acquisition of property, which would include motor vehicles and other motorized equipment, and to provide for the preservation and protection of such property and equipment; and

WHEREAS, Cobb County operates a Fleet Management Department which has been nationally recognized for its excellence and has the capacity to provide fleet maintenance of City vehicles and equipment; and

WHEREAS, the City previously authorized and executed an agreement with Cobb County to performs fleet management services to provide for the maintenance, repair, fueling, replacement acquisition and disposal of City vehicles and equipment, which has expired; and

WHEREAS, the City finds it in the best interests of its citizens in the interest of efficient and cost-effective government to avail itself of the fleet maintenance services of the County by way of an intergovernmental agreement.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council of the City of Powder Springs that the Mayor or Mayor Pro Tem is authorized to execute a renewal of the Intergovernmental Agreement with Cobb County for fleet maintenance services of the County, after review and approval by the City Attorney. This resolution shall become effective immediately upon approval.
