

RESOLUTION NO. 2022 - 135

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT WITH SAMSARA FOR THE INSTALLATION AND MAINTENANCE OF A FLEET MANAGEMENT SYSTEM FOR AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$50,000; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.


WHEREAS Samsara is a fleet management solution that provides GPS tracking, dashboard cameras, and routing and dispatch, and data collection on vehicle performance and breakdowns to help fleet operators track the physical location of their fleets and monitor driver behavior; and


WHEREAS the City of Powder Springs desires to manage its fleet more efficiently and reduce mileage and fuel reduce accidents, and it solicited and obtained quotes for the installation and maintenance of a fleet management solution; and

WHEREAS after a thorough review and evaluation of each proposal, the evaluation team determined that Samsara submitted the proposal deemed to be most advantageous to the City.


NOW THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council of the City of Powder Springs that the Mayor is authorized to execute an agreement with Samsara for the installation and maintenance of a fleet management system for an amount not to exceed \$50,000.00, subject to review and approval by the City Attorney. This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon adoption.






