

RESOLUTION NO. 2023 - 202

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE A DEDUCTIVE CHANGE ORDER IN THE AMOUNT OF 5,796.67 RELATING TO THE PURCHASE OF PARK FURNITURE IN POWDER SPRINGS PARK PAVILIONS; AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND CITY STAFF TO EXECUTE DOCUMENTS NEEDED TO CLOSE SAID PROJECT; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.


WHEREAS the City of Powder Springs (the “City”) previously approved the purchase and installation of furniture in the pavilions at Powder Springs Park under the Special Purpose Local Option Sales Tax (“SPLOST”) program through Resolution 2023 – 027; and


WHEREAS the City completed said project to include picnic tables and accessibility seating but continues to meet delays and price increases for the manufacturers for game tables; and


WHEREAS the City desires to proceed with the purchase of game tables at a later date and close the current project with a deductive change order.


