A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE TEMPORARY CLOSURE AND USE OF THE MUNICIPAL PARKING LOT LOCATED BETWEEN MARIETTA STREET AND HOTEL AVENUE FOR A TEMPORARY SPECIAL EVENT ON FEBRUARY 18, 2023 TO ACCOMMODATE BLACK HISTORY MONTH ENTREPRENEURS DAY; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS the City of Powder Springs ("City") has received a temporary special event application from the Book Worm bookstore to conduct the third annual Black History Month Entrepreneurs Day with a special author panel on February 18, 2023, which requires the closure of all or a portion of the municipal parking lot owned by the City on Marietta Street and Hotel Avenue;

WHEREAS the City desires to accommodate the temporary event and allow the temporary closure and use of the municipal parking lot in support of celebrating Black History month and creating destinations and an atmosphere of community that facilitate economic development and tourism;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council of the City of Powder Springs that it authorizes the temporary closure and use of the municipal parking lot on Marietta Street and Hotel Avenue on February 18, 2023, subject to the applicant providing security and traffic control as determined by the Chief of Police, providing for sanitation and clean up following the event as determined by the Public Works Director and providing written notice of the event at least three weeks in advance to Liz by Design, Rooted, the Event Station and all businesses fronting Marietta Street and Broad Street. This resolution is effective immediately upon approval.
