

**RESOLUTION NO. 2018-070**

**A RESOLUTION APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE AN AMENDMENT TO THE PROGRAM MANAGEMENT AGREEMENT WITH CROY ENGINEERING FOR PROFESSIONAL ENGINEERING SERVICES RELATED TO STREETScape IMPROVEMENTS ON BROAD STREET FOR AN AMOUNT OF \$16,500.00; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.**


**WHEREAS**, the City of Powder Springs (“City”) Public Works Department has identified Broad Street as one of the next roads in need of repair and resurfacing under the standards of the road rating program; and

**WHEREAS**, the City’s Downtown Development Authority has purchased properties on Broad Street for rehabilitation and subsequent rental or sale and said properties are negatively impacted by current road and sidewalk conditions; and


**WHEREAS**, the City desires to improve Broad Street with a streetscape plan consistent with the improvements made on the adjoining roads in the downtown and desires to engage its manager for the Special Purpose Local Option Sales Tax (“SPLOST”) program, Croy Engineering, to develop the engineered plans to construct the desired improvements; and


**NOW THEREFORE**, be it hereby resolved by the Mayor and Council of the City of Powder Springs that it approves and authorizes the Mayor to execute an agreement with Croy Engineering for professional engineering services to develop plans for streetscape improvements on Broad Street for an amount of \$16,500.00, subject to review and approval by the City Attorney. This resolution shall be effective immediately upon adoption.
