A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF ROADS AND PUBLIC SPACES IN OR ADJACENT TO THE DOWNTOWN PARK TO FACILITATE THE CITY OF POWDER SPRINGS CONCERT SERIES ON AUGUST 15 AND OCTOBER 3 AND THE SEAFOOD FESTIVAL PARK GRAND OPENING SEPTEMBER 11 TO SEPTEMBER 13; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.


WHEREAS, the City of Powder Springs (the “City”) has scheduled the grand opening for the new downtown park as the Bring the Sea to the Springs Seafood Festival September 11 to September 13, 2020 and its 2020 Concert Series on August 15 and October 3, 2020;


WHEREAS, said events will be held at the Hardy Family Automotive Group Amphitheater in the new downtown park and will require the closure of Pineview Drive, Oakview Drive, Jackson Way and South Town Square surrounding the park;


NOW THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council of the City of Powder Springs that the temporary closure and use of roads within and adjacent to the downtown park is hereby approved for the Concert Series on August 15 and October 3 and the park grand opening at the Bring the Sea to the Springs Seafood Festival from September 11 to September 13. This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon adoption.


SO RESOLVED this 20th day of July 2020.




