A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE OF 1500 SANITATION CARTS AT A COST OF \$84,494; AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT WITH TOTER TO EFFECTUATE THE PURCHASE; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS the City of Powder Springs ("City") in 2002 identified the need and thus requested and received quotes to initiate a replacement program of sanitation carts that are on average dated by more than twenty years; and

WHEREAS the City purchased the first 1500 replacement set in 2022 and the second 1500 replacement set in 2023; and

WHEREAS the sanitation supervisor recommends, and the City finds it in the public interest to proceed with the third replacement by continuing with the same product supplied by Toter, whose product bid amount is less than three percent (\$2325) more than an alternate product bid.

NOW THEREFORE, be it hereby resolved by the Mayor and Council of the City of Powder Springs that the bid of Toter for 1500 new sanitation carts in the amount of \$84,494 is hereby accepted and the Mayor is authorized to execute an agreement to effectuate same after review and approval by the City Attorney.
