

RESOLUTION 2017-075

A RESOLUTION APPROVING AGREEMENTS WITH REVVED UP KIDS FOR ITS DONATION OF IN-KIND SERVICES VOLUNTEERING SAFETY INSTRUCTION TO PARTICIPANTS OF THE 2017 SUMMER YOUTH ENRICHMENT CAMP HOSTED BY THE POWDER SPRINGS FIRST UNITED METHODIST CHURCH, TAPP MIDDLE SCHOOL AND THE CITY OF POWDER SPRINGS; RATIFYING THE AGREEMENTS EXECUTED BY THE MAYOR FOR THE VOLUNTEER SERVICES; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, a summer youth enrichment camp was conducted by the youth ambassador committee known as Growing in Powder Springs and Growing Ambassadors in Powder Springs (“GIPS ‘n GAPS”) and hosted by the Powder Springs First United Methodist Church, Tapp Middle School and the City of Powder Springs from June 19 to June 29, 2017 at Tapp Middle School;

WHEREAS, Revved Up Kids provided training and instruction on personal safety to the participants at the youth camp and prior to camp submitted service and donation agreements for city signature, and the City desires to approve and ratify the execution of the agreements;


