


WHEREAS the representatives for the approved applicant, Omega Psi Phi, notified the City that the correct and full name of the applicant host is Mu Mu Mu Chapter of Omega Psi Phi Fraternity, Inc., and the City desires to correct and update the approval adopted by Resolution 2023-112 accordingly;


NOW THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council of the City of Powder Springs that it corrects and updates Resolution 2023-112 to authorize the closure and rental of Thurman Springs Park and the closure of streets in the downtown identified by the Chief of Police in order for Mu Mu Mu Chapter of Psi Phi Fraternity, Inc. to conduct the Tri Music Festival on August 19, 2023 between the hours of 6:00PM and 10:00PM (setup at 4:00PM and breakdown by 11:00PM).






