

RESOLUTION NO. 2023 – 150

**A RESOLUTION APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE AMENDMENT NO. 1 TO THE AGREEMENT WITH COMMUNITIES IN SCHOOLS OF GEORGIA IN MARIETTA/COBB COUNTY TO PERFORM TUTORING SERVICES; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES**

**WHEREAS** the City entered into an agreement with Communities in Schools of Georgia in Marietta/Cobb County last year to provide tutoring services in local schools to help address the learning gap experienced by local students due to the pandemic; and


**WHEREAS** the Agreement with Communities in Schools of Georgia in Marietta/Cobb County provides it may be renewed for an additional one-year term upon agreement of the parties; and


**WHEREAS** the City set aside funding from its American Rescue Plan Act grant sufficient to continue the Agreement for an additional twelve months, and the Mayor and City Council desire to continue the work of Communities and Schools in local schools for an additional school year.


**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED** by the Mayor and Council of the City of Powder Springs that it approves and authorizes the Mayor to execute Amendment No. 1 to the Agreement for Vendor/Contractor Services with Communities in Schools of Georgia in Marietta/Cobb County to perform tutoring services for students at elementary schools in Powder Springs, subject to review and approval by the City Attorney. This resolution shall become effective immediately upon adoption.






