

RESOLUTION NO. 2020 - 133

A RESOLUTION APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE SUBRECIPIENT AGREEMENT WITH THE COBB COUNTY COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT PROGRAM OFFICE TO PARTICIPATE IN THE OFFICE OF JUSTICE PROGRAMS FOR THE RECEIPT AND ALOCATION OF FUNDS FOR USE IN THE PREVENTION, PREPARATION AND REPSONSE TO THE CORONAVIRUS; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, subsequent to the World Health Organization’s declaration that COVID-19 was a world health emergency and a global pandemic, the declaration of a National Public Health Emergency for the United States on March 13, 2020, and the declaration a State Public Health Emergency in Georgia on March 14, 2020, Congress authorized Emergency Appropriations for Coronavirus Health Response and Agency Operations that provide funding under the Coronavirus Emergency Supplemental Funding (“CESF”) administered by the Cobb County Community Development Block Grant (“CDBG”) Program Office; and

WHEREAS, the CDBG Program Office received appropriation from the Office of Justice Program (“OJP”) of the Department of Justice and solicited applications for the OJP funding for costs incurred by the Police Department and Municipal Court to prevent, prepare for and respond to the coronavirus;


WHEREAS, the City of Powder Springs (“the City”) applied for and was awarded funds under the CESF program administered by the CDBG Program Office for Personal Protective Equipment (“PPE”) needs of the Police Department and Municipal Court, and the City agrees to accept said funds for activities determined to be CESF eligible by CDBG;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council of the City of Powder Springs that it approves and authorizes the Mayor to execute the FY20 Coronavirus Emergency Supplemental Funding (“CESF”) Subgrantee Agreement (2020-VD-BX-1385, 2020-V20P) for receipt of CESF funding, after review and approval by the City Attorney. This Resolution shall be effective upon adoption.




