A RESOLUTION DECLARING AS SURPLUS AND AUTHORIZING DISPOSITION OF POLICE DEPARTMENT VEHICLES, FURNITURE, FIXTURES AND EQUIPMENT; ESTABLISHING AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the City of Powder Springs ("City") owns vehicles with excessive mileage that are no longer serviceable as well as an asset forfeiture seized vehicle;

WHEREAS, certain furniture, fixtures and equipment ("FF&E") at the City's police department are no longer serviceable or functional;

WHEREAS, the City finds it in the best interest of the City to declare as surplus and dispose of or sell said property.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Mayor is authorized to execute any documentation necessary to effectuate the sale, disposal or auction of said property. This resolution shall become effective immediately upon adoption.
