A RESOLUTION APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT WITH BONUS BUILDING CARE TO DISINFECT AND DEEP CLEAN CITY FACILITIES FOR AN AMOUNT OF \$15,097; ESTABLISHING AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the City of Powder Springs ("City"), Cobb County, the state of Georgia and the United States has experienced an event of critical significance as a result of novel coronavirus (COVID-19) pandemic which led the City's order to close its facilities to the public;

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Executive Order of the Governor for the State of Georgia and consistent with the guidelines recommended by the Centers for Disease Control and the Department of Public Health, the City is preparing for the gradual re-opening of its facilities;

WHEREAS, the City sought and obtained quotes and desires to accept and approve the proposal from Bonus Building Care to provide deep cleaning and disinfecting services;

WHEREAS, the City engaged its engineer to secure construction plans for the installation of physical barriers in certain areas of City facilities and to secure contractor services to complete said
