A RESOLUTION APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT WITH OPEN-GOV TO IMPLEMENT AN OCCUPATIONAL TAX MODULE FOR A ONE TIME IMPLEMENTATION COST OF \$46,000 AND AN ANNUAL OPERATING SOFTWARE FEE OF \$29,000; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS the City of Powder Springs ("City") previously authorized implementation of a cloud-based accounting system from Tyler Technologies, Inc. for use in financial accounting operations; and

WHEREAS the system offered by Tyler Technologies is insufficient to meet the needs of the City's operations; and

WHEREAS the City has assessed the software offered by Open-Gov and has determined it meets the processing as well as accounting needs of both Community Development and Finance in issuing and accounting for occupational tax certificates and finds it in the public interest to implement the program offered by Open-Gov.

BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED by the Council for the City of Powder Springs that it approves and authorizes the Mayor to execute an agreement with Open-Gov for its occupational tax certificate module for an implementation fee of \$46,000 and an annual operating software fee of \$29,000, renewal for three one-year terms each with a corresponding increase of 5%, subject to review and approval by the City Attorney.
