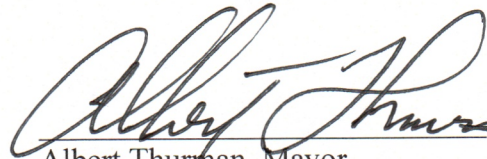
A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE A CONSERVATION EASEMENT GRANTED FOR THE WALTON STREET RESIDENTIAL DEVELOPMENT; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the subdivision development known as the Walton Street community contains a creek considered to be state waters and is required to be protected by a buffer; and

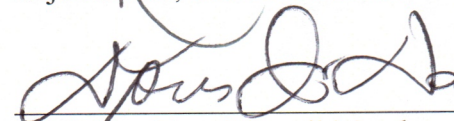
WHEREAS, the owner desires to grant and the City of Powder Springs desires to accept a conservation easement over an area 4662 square feet in size to protect the stream buffer area.

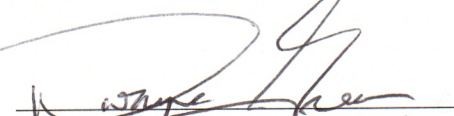
NOW THEREFORE BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council of the City of Powder Springs that a conservation easement granted over an area of stream buffer 4662 square feet in size is hereby accepted, and the Mayor is authorized to execute an acceptance of same, subject to review and approval by the City Attorney. This Resolution shall be effective upon adoption.

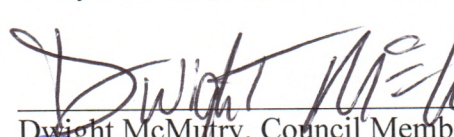

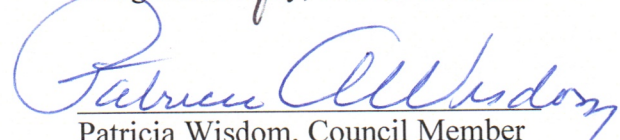

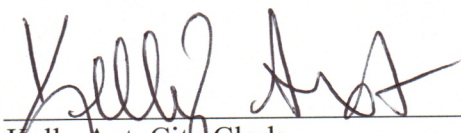
