

RESOLUTION 2026 - 085

A RESOLUTION APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT WITH ENVIRONMENTAL REMEDIES TO PUMP THREE GREASE TRAPS AND WASTE LINES ON BROAD STREET FOR A FEE OF \$645 EACH PUMP FOR EACH TANK OR \$1935 FOR EACH TANK ANNUALLY; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

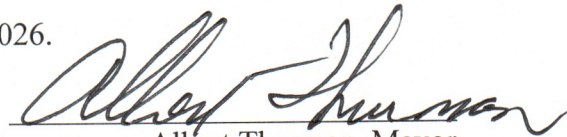
WHEREAS the City of Powder Springs ("City") did previously approve and authorize the installation and short-term maintenance of grease trap and waste lines on Broad Street; and

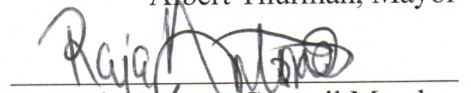
WHEREAS grease trap pumping frequency depends on the level and amount of use but is anticipated to be at least once per quarter; and

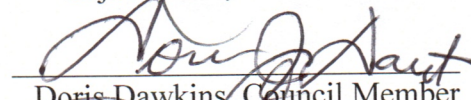
WHEREAS bids were solicited and obtained to pump the grease trap as required by Cobb County ordinances, and the City desires to accept the bid submitted by as the lowest responsive and responsible bidder.

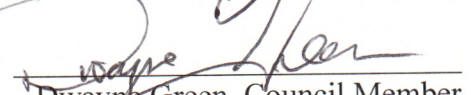
NOW THEREFORE BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council of the City of Powder Springs that the bid submitted by. for an amount of \$645 per pump for each tank or \$1935 for an annual fee to pump each grease trap located under Broad Street is approved, with an option to renew for 3 one-year terms, and the Mayor is authorized to execute an agreement with Environmental Remedies after review and approval by the City Attorney.

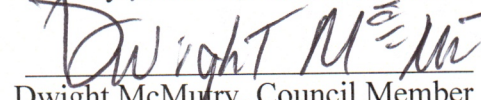

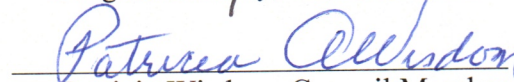

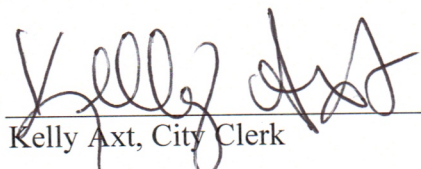
