A RESOLUTION APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT WITH CMC, INC. FOR AN AMOUNT OF \$348,172.39 TO COMPLETE INTERSECTION IMPROVEMENTS AT FLORENCE ROAD AND US278 UNDER THE 2016 SPECIAL PURPOSE LOCAL OPTION SALES TAX PROGRAM; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the 2016 Special Purpose Local Option Sales Tax (SPLOST) program general streets improvements, including improvements at the intersection of Florence Road and US278; and

WHEREAS, the City of Powder Springs ("City") solicited and obtained bids to complete said improvements, and the City desires to accept the recommendation of it SPLOST Program Manager, Croy Engineering, LLC ("Croy") to award the contract to CMC, Inc. as the lowest responsive and responsible bidder.

**BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED** by the Council for the City of Powder Springs that it accepts and authorizes the Mayor to execute an agreement with CMC, Inc. for an amount of \$348,172.39 to improvements at the intersection of Florence Road and US278 under the SPLOST program, subject to review and approval by the City Attorney. This resolution shall be effective immediately upon adoption.
