A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE OF A 2022 CHEVROLET COLORADO WORK TRUCK FOR USE BY STORMWATER AND COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT STAFF; AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE OF LIGHTS AND DECALS FOR SAID TRUCK; AUTHORIZING AND APPROVING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT FOR SAID PURCAHSE; APPROVING A CONTINGENCY OF \$10,000 FOR LIGHTS AND DECALS; ESTABLISHING AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS the City of Powder Springs has received notice that the work vehicle currently used by stormwater and community development staff is recommended for replacement given the expected high expense associated with continued use of said vehicle; and

WHEREAS the existing vehicle is a 2006 with over 130,000 miles and requires a new transmission, a fluid pressure replacement, an acceleration repair, four new tires, significant fluid leak repairs, and s front differential among other things, all of which are expected to exceed \$6,000: and

WHEREAS even with said repairs and replacement, the useful life of the vehicle is approximately 150,000 miles for this 5-cylinder type of engine; and

WHEREAS the current list price for a 2022 Chevrolet Colorado is \$35,563.95, and the City desires to proceed with the purchase of said vehicle and authorize a contingency for the placement of lights and decals as a city vehicle for infrastructure and development projects and for supply chain delays.

**BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED** by the Council for the City of Powder Springs that it authorizes the purchase of a 2022 Chevrolet Colorado for an amount of \$35,563.95 and a contingency of up to \$10,000 for lights and decals and authorizes the Mayor to execute any agreements required to complete said purchase, subject to review and approval by the City Attorney. This resolution shall be effective immediately upon adoption.
