
A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE AN AMENDMENT TO THE MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING WITH THE SOUTH COBB ARTS ALLIANCE FOR THE IMPLEMENTATION OF THE ART PLACEMAKING PROJECT; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.


WHEREAS the City of Powder Springs (the "City") previously approved a memorandum of understanding with the South Cobb Arts Alliance ("SCAA") under Resolution 2023-137 to implement a grant from the American Association of Retired People ("AARP") for an art project proposed by the City in the implementation of the City's placemaking program; and

WHEREAS the City desires to complete seven bike arts projects in recognition of its historical seven springs and finds it in the public interest to engage the assistance of the SCAA to implement two additional bike art projects.


NOW THEREFORE, be it hereby resolved by the Mayor and Council of the City of Powder Springs that it authorizes the Mayor to execute an amendment to the Memorandum of Understanding with the SCAA, in form substantially similar to the attached, following review and approval by the City Attorney, to add two additional bike art projects for a sum of \$2200.




