

RESOLUTION NO. 2020 -124


A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING THE CONVEYANCE OF PROPERTY FROM COBB COUNTY THAT IS LOCATED ON HOPKINS ROAD AND WAS ACQUIRED UNDER THE HAZARD MITIGATION GRANT PROGRAM AS A RESULT OF PAST FLOODING; AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE DOCUMENTS REQUIRED TO ACCEPT THE CONVEYANCE; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.


WHEREAS, the City of Powder Springs (“City”) previously acquired properties along Hopkins Road under the Hazard Mitigation Grant Program that were substantially damaged during past flooding events and created a disc golf course for public use and enjoyment;


WHEREAS, during the preparation of a plat to combine all flood properties into one lot for the purpose of assigning an address for the disc golf recreational improvements on Hopkins Road, the City determined that one lot had not included in an earlier conveyance of properties from the County to the City, and the City and County desire to complete the conveyance to include said lot;

NOW, THEREFORE, IS IT HEREBY RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council for the City of Powder Springs that the City accepts the conveyance of property from Cobb County described in the attached quitclaim deed and authorizes the Mayor to execute documents required to complete said conveyance. This resolution shall become effective immediately upon adoption.






