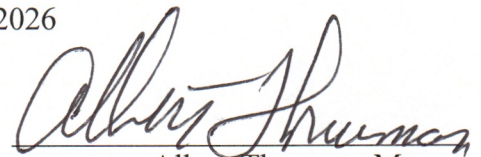
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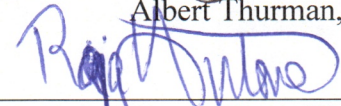
**WHEREAS** the City of Powder Springs ("City") has received a temporary event application from Seven Springs Church to host a community social and praise event on May 23, 2026 from 3PM to 9PM, with the community social and marketplace beginning at 4:30 and the praise event beginning at 6:40PM and concluding by 8PM; and

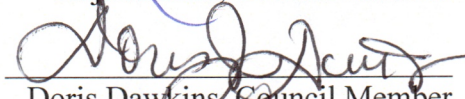
**WHEREAS** the City finds it in the public interest to accommodate the special event to further its strategic priority of creating destinations that appeal to and draw residents and visitors to the city's amenities.

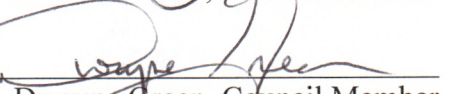
**NOW THEREFORE BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED** by the Mayor and Council of the City of Powder Springs that it authorizes the temporary closure and use of Thurman Springs Park between 3PM for set up and 9PM for a summer social and praise event between 4:30PM and 8:00 PM on May 23, 2026 to accommodate the Seven Springs Church temporary event permit request subject to the transportation, parking, security and cleanup requirements and conditions established by the Police and Infrastructure and Amenities Departments and the issuance of a written notice at least 30 days prior to the event to downtown businesses and Springside apartments about the special event, with a copy to the City's event coordinator.

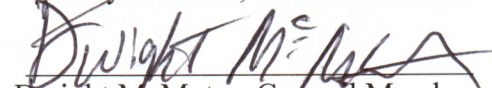

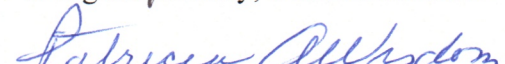

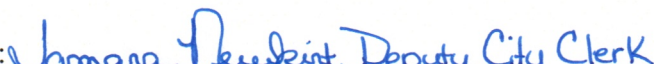
