

RESOLUTION NO. 2023 - 087

A RESOLUTION APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT WITH CROY ENGINEERING IN THE AMOUNT OF \$57,467.50 TO DEVELOP A TRUCK TRAFFIC ROUTING PLAN; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES

WHEREAS the City of Powder Springs (the "City") experiences a large volume of truck traffic on its local roads, including its historic downtown, damaging infrastructure and impacting local traffic movement;


WHEREAS the City desires to manage truck traffic to, from and through the City and direct the trucks to appropriate roadways to minimize these impacts and recommend the best roads for accessing the City's industrial areas;


WHEREAS the City solicited and obtained one proposal to develop a truck traffic routing plan that will include truck restrictions for appropriate roadways;


WHEREAS the City finds the proposal submitted by Croy Engineering to be in the interest of public safety and welfare and desires to accept said proposal.


NOW THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council of the City of Powder Springs that it approves and authorizes the Mayor to execute an agreement with Croy Engineering for an amount of \$57,467.50 to develop a truck traffic routing plan, subject to review and approval by the City Attorney. This resolution shall become effective immediately upon adoption.


