## **RESOLUTION 2018 - 086**

A RESOLUTION APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT WITH BARTOW PAVING FOR AN AMOUNT OF \$1,528,392.10 TO RESURFACE CERTAIN CITY ROADS; AUTHORIZING THE SPECIAL PURPOSE LOCAL OPTION SALES TAX PROGRAM MANAGER TO COMPLETE CERTAIN PROJECT CLOSE OUT DOCUMENTS AT THE CONCLUSION OF THE PROJECT; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, through its Special Purpose Local Option Sales Tax ("SPLOST") program manager, the City of Powder Springs ("City") solicited and received proposals to resurface Buffington Way, Pembrooke Way, Sweetbriar Lane, Warwick Lane, Pinetree Court, Morning Dew Court, Spring Industrial Drive, Spring Gate Drive, Christian Drive and Powder Springs-Dallas Road under the 2016 SPLOST program;

WHEREAS, the City concurs with the recommendation of the SPLOST program manager and finds it in the interest of public health and welfare to authorize Bartow Paving to complete said resurfacing as the lowest responsive and responsible bidder;

**NOW THEREFORE**, be it hereby resolved by the Mayor and Council of the City of Powder Springs that the proposal submitted by Bartow Paving for an amount of \$1,528,392.10 to resurface the above-described city roads is approved, and the Mayor is authorized to execute an agreement with Bartow Paving for said resurfacing project, subject to review and approval by the City Attorney.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** by the Council that the SPLOST program manager is authorized to sign all project close out documents at the conclusion of the resurfacing project. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon adoption.
