

RESOLUTION NO. 2022 – 158

A RESOLUTION APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT WITH GEORGIA POWER TO RETROFIT INDOOR LIGHTING WITHIN CITY OF POWDER SPRINGS FACILITIES LOCATED AT THE FORD CENTER CAMPUS AND POLICE DEPARTMENT; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES

WHEREAS Georgia Power has an incentive program to retrofit indoor lighting that covers seventy percent of the project retrofit cost as well as reducing energy costs; and

WHEREAS Georgia Powder inventoried lighting within the facilities on the Ford Center Campus and the Police Department and recommends retrofit at a public cost of \$9,4560.0, which will thereafter result in an estimated annual energy savings of \$13,297; and

WHEREAS the City finds it in the public interest to participate in the Georgia Power indoor lighting retrofit program to achieve annual energy savings costs.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council of the City of Powder Springs that it approves and authorizes the Mayor to execute an agreement with Georgia Power to retrofit indoor lighting in the City's facilities located at the Ford Center campus and at the Police Department at a City contribution of \$9,456.06, subject to review and approval by the City Attorney. This resolution shall become effective immediately upon adoption.
