RESOLUTION NO. 2021 - 028

A RESOLUTION APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE A CHANGE ORDER WITH C.W. MATTHEWS CONTRACTING COMPANY, INC. FOR AN AMOUNT OF \$29,594.23; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the City of Powder Springs previously approved and executed an agreement with C.W. Matthews to complete transportation, intersection and sewer improvements on Powder Springs Road at its intersections with Flint Hill and Pinegrove Road;

WHEREAS, given the types of sanitary sewer improvements planned at the location, it has been determined that ductile iron is more appropriate than PVC and the City has asked C.W. Matthews to substitute the material;

WHEREAS, despite the removal of the old road access of Flint Hill Road, certain motor vehicle operators are making the turning movement across the old road bed of Flint Hill rather than at the intersection, compromising safety of other motorists, and the City has asked C.W. Matthews to install guardrail at the old road entrance;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council of the City of Powder Springs that it approves and authorizes the Mayor to execute a change order with C.W. Matthews in the amount of \$25,594.23 to substitute sanitary sewer materials and to install guardrail as part of the improvements on Powder Springs Road, subject to review and approval by the City Attorney. This resolution shall become effective immediately upon adoption.
