

ORDINANCE 2016-014

AN ORDINANCE TO ADOPT THE BUDGET FOR FISCAL YEAR 2017; TO ESTABLISH AN EFFECTIVE DATE; TO REQUIRE PRIOR APPROVAL PRIOR TO EXPENDITURES FROM THE CAPITAL PROJECTS FUND; TO REPEAL CONFLICTING ORDINANCES; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, a balanced budget has been submitted to and reviewed by the Mayor and Council of the City of Powder Springs (the "City"), and the City has determined that the budget prepared for fiscal year 2017 is consistent with applicable regulations, laws and policies and it therefore desires to adopt said budget;

NOW THEREFORE, the Mayor and Council of the City of Powder Springs hereby ordain that the budget ordinance for the fiscal year 2017 be adopted as provided in the attached schedule.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, that all ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed; that existing job descriptions and pay scale classifications shall be revised to properly reflect changes effected by this ordinance; that the budget approval shall include the transfer of \$4,306 to the General Fund for the summer intern program, \$50,000 to the General Fund for the grant writer, \$20,000 to the Downtown Development Authority for the purpose of securing legal services to initiate town center redevelopment activities of acquisition and financing and \$25,000 to the Development Authority for the purpose of available property inventory update and marketing; and that the budget approval shall include the transfer of the following amounts to the capital projects fund, which may be expended upon approval of the Mayor and Council:

- a. Signage at Police Department \$50,000
- b. LMIG Match \$22,400
- c. Emergency Preparedness \$143,000
- d. Initiate town center redevelopment, starting with acquisition \$503,877

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, that this ordinance shall become effective on July 1, 2016.
