## INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT BETWEEN

## THE CITY OF SMYRNA, GA AND THE CITY OF POWDER SPRINGS, GA FOR

## THE TERMINATION OF 911 EMERGENCY CALL ANSWERING SERVICES

**THIS AGREEMENT,** made by and between the City of Smyrna, located in the State of Georgia, hereinafter referred to as Smyrna, and the City of Powder Springs, located in the State of Georgia, hereinafter referred to as Powder Springs.

## WITTNESSETH

**WHEREAS,** the Parties hereto did previously enter into an Interlocal Agreement Between The City of Smyrna, Ga and The City Of Powder Springs, Ga for the Provision of 911 Emergency Call Answering Services whereby The City of Smyrna would receive and dispatch emergency calls on behalf of The City of Powder Springs beginning November 1, 2017 (hereinafter, "the 911 Agreement"); and

WHEREAS, the parties hereto now desire to terminate the 911 Agreement; and

**WHEREAS,** the term of the 911Agreement was to be for a 10 (ten) year period but may be terminated prior to that time only by mutual agreement in writing of both Smyrna and Powder Springs, as stated in the 911Agreement.

**NOW THEREFORE, FOR AND IN CONSIDERATION** of the mutual covenants of the Parties and other good and valuable consideration, the Parties hereto agree as follows:

- 1. The City of Smyrna Chief of Police and the City of Powder Springs Chief of Police and the City of Smyrna E911 Director have reached a mutual agreement to terminate the 911 Agreement.
- 2. The City of Powder Springs Chief of Police will coordinate with the Cobb County Emergency 911 Center to establish the technical steps needing to be accomplished for their return.
- 3. The City of Powder Springs Chief of Police and the Cobb County E911 Director will determine the date and time for the transfer of Powder Springs back to Cobb County E911.
- 4. The City of Smyrna E911 center will continue to provide the 911 emergency call answering services to the City of Powder Springs until the transfer date.
