A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT WITH HIGHWAY SERVICES TO RESTRIPE TRAVEL LANES ON RICHARD D. SAILORS PARKWAY FOR AN AMOUNT OF \$67,486.10; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the City of Powder Springs ("City") was notified about the availability of additional funding from the Georgia Department of Transportation for striping or signage improvements on local roads, subject to a City funding match;

WHEREAS, the Public Works Department identified a need for re-striping travel lanes on Richard D. Sailors Parkway from Florence Road to Flint Hill Road and has made application for the grant dollars from GDOT, using budgeted street dollars for the City's local match;

WHEREAS, in the interest of public safety and welfare, the City solicited and obtain quotes to re-stripe Richard D. Sailors Parkway before June 30 and desires to accept the quote submitted by Highway Services.

NOW THEREFORE, be it hereby resolved by the Mayor and Council of the City of Powder Springs that it accepts the quote submitted by Highway Services in the amount of \$67,486.10 and authorizes the Mayor to execute an agreement with Highway Services, subject to review and approval by the City Attorney. This resolution shall be effective at adoption.
