A RESOLUTION APPROVING A DEDUCTIVE CHANGE ORDER TO AN AGREEMENT WITH BARTOW PAVING COMPANY, INC. FOR THE 2018 LOCAL MAINTENANCE IMPROVEMENT GRANT PROGRAM RESURFACING PROJECT; AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE ANY DOCUMENT NECESSARY TO EFFECTUATE SUCH CHANGE ORDER; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.
