

RESOLUTION 2025 - 030

A RESOLUTION APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE A SUPPLEMENTAL AGREEMENT WITH THE ATLANTA REGIONAL COMMISSION AND GEORGIA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION ACCEPTING ADDITIONAL FUNDING ASSISTANCE FOR THE OLD LOST MOUNTAIN TRAIL CONNECTOR; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.


WHEREAS the City of Powder Springs (“City”) previously accepted federal grant awards for the Old Lost Mountain Trail (“OLM”) connector project Resolutions 2024-131 and 140 for an amount of \$450,000 [federal \$360,000 | local \$90,000] for the specified scope of work; and

WHEREAS the City completed a competitive process to select an engineer to begin said project and approved an agreement under Resolution 2024-054 with Heath Lineback for the OLM project; and


WHEREAS the Atlanta Regional Commission (“ARC”) and Georgia Department of Transportation (“GDOT”) have notified the City of additional funds to complete the pre-construction engineering design activities (“PE”) and the City desires to authorize the additional amount in order to complete all steps for PE required by ARC and GDOT and to better position the City when it applies for right of way and construction funding assistance.

BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED by the Council for the City of Powder Springs that it approves and authorizes the Mayor to execute a supplemental agreement with the ARC and GDOT to authorize and approve PE work at \$850,000 [federal \$680,000 | local \$170,000].


