A RESOLUTION APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE CHIEF OF POLICE TO EXECUTE A MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING WITH VICTIM SERVICE PROVIDERS TO PROVIDE SUPPORT SERVICES TO VICTIMS OF CRIME IN A COLLABORATIVE EFFORT WITH OTHER COBB AGENCIES; ESTABLISHING AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the community of Cobb County is united in its efforts to provide on-going, comprehensive, non-duplicative, healing, consistent, support services to victims of crime in the Cobb Community;

WHEREAS, the Powder Springs Police Department along with its partner agencies has agreed to continue in the existing mutually supportive, formal partnerships as an interactive way of working together to provide services to crime victims through the coordinated efforts of professionals and agencies in a multi-disciplinary team approach; and

WHEREAS, the signing of a Memorandum of Understanding signifies the collaborative continued support and involvement of each agency listed in providing comprehensive services to victims of crime in the community of Cobb County, and the Mayor and Council deem efforts to provide support services to victims of crime to be in the best interests of the City for the health, safety and welfare of its citizens;

NOW THEREFORE, be it hereby resolved by the Mayor and Council for the City of Powder Springs that an updated agreement with participating, agencies and organizations is hereby approved and the Chief of Police is authorized to execute the attached agreement after review and approval by the City Attorney. This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon adoption.
