AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE BUDGET FOR FISCAL YEAR 2019 TO ALLOCATE FUNDS TO FOR EXPENSES ASSOCIATED WITH HOLIDAY BONUS; TO ESTABLISH AN EFFECTIVE DATE; TO REPEAL CONFLICTING ORDINANCES; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council of the City of Powder Springs have determined that circumstances warrant a change in Fiscal year 2019 budget to allocate funds from savings in the police department salaries and wages budget to other departmental salaries and wages budgets for expenses associated with a holiday bonus;

NOW THEREFORE, the Mayor and Council of the City of Powder Springs hereby ordain that the budget ordinance for the fiscal year 2019 be amended as provided in the attached Schedule A;




