A RESOLUTION APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE THE ANNUAL SUBRECIPIENT AGREEMENT WITH THE COBB COUNTY COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT (CDBG) PROGRAM OFFICE FOR THE USE OF CDBG FUNDS FOR PUBLIC FACILITIES AND INFRASTRUCTURE IMPROVEMENTS FOR PROGRAM YEAR 2024; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.
